Overview and Objective

The Junior Golf Camp provides a safe and focused environment for the serious youth player to develop his or her golf game with the support of a team of dedicated PGA Professionals. The program emphasizes skills development, etiquette, sportsmanship, and character building, while at the same time allowing players to interact with their peers in a competitive yet collegial atmosphere.

Code of Conduct

The Links at Terranea strives to create an enjoyable and memorable atmosphere for all guests. In order to create this atmosphere we require all campers to adhere to the set guidelines known as the "Code of Conduct." By following the "Code of Conduct", players benefit from the game of golf by gaining a better understanding both rules and proper etiquette. Juniors must conduct themselves in a disciplined manner, demonstrating courtesy and sportsmanship, acting with integrity at all times, and abiding by the USGA Rules of Golf. Juniors should be diligent in their care of the golf course. This includes replacing putting and chipping green pins, raking bunkers, replacing divots, and repairing ball-marks and damage on greens, even if someone else may have been responsible. The "Code of Conduct" is to be followed at all times when on property at The Links at Terranea.

Violations of the "Code of Conduct" include but are not limited to:

- Unsportsmanlike conduct, including abusive language, club throwing or breaking, disrespect to staff associates or fellow juniors, or abuse of golf course property.
- Use or association with drugs, alcohol, smoking, or other tobacco products.
- Conduct unbecoming of a Junior Golf Camper, such as acting in anger or creating distractions.
- Gambling or loitering.
- Not adhering to the dress code at The Links at Terranea.

Dress Code

- Collared shirts or mock turtlenecks are required to be tucked in at all times.
- Boy's shorts must be Bermuda style and length. Belts are required.
- Girl's fashion shirts without collar must have sleeves, but girl's collared shirts may be sleeveless. Girl's Shirts must not rise above the belt line at anytime during the golf swing. Girl's shorts must be no more than 5" above the knee or the inseam of the shorts must measure at least 5".
- Hats and Visors must be worn brim forward.
- Tennis Shoes are allowed.

Denim, swimming attire, t-shirts, gym shorts, running shorts, tank tops, halter tops, mesh shirts, cut-off shorts, short-shorts, and other dress of similar nature are inappropriate on property.
